

In both geography and history, useful information can be obtained from studying photographs. One method is to answer **SATO** questions.

Senses

1. What can you see?
2. What could you hear if you were there?
3. What could you smell if you were there?

Action

4. What is happening in the photograph?
5. Why was it happening?
6. What could be going on to the left and right of the scene in the photograph?

Time

7. What do you think happened immediately before this photograph was taken?
8. What do you think might happen next?
9. How do you think the scene in the photograph has changed since the photograph was taken in 2006?

Overall

10. What does this photograph tell us, e.g. about people and place/location?
