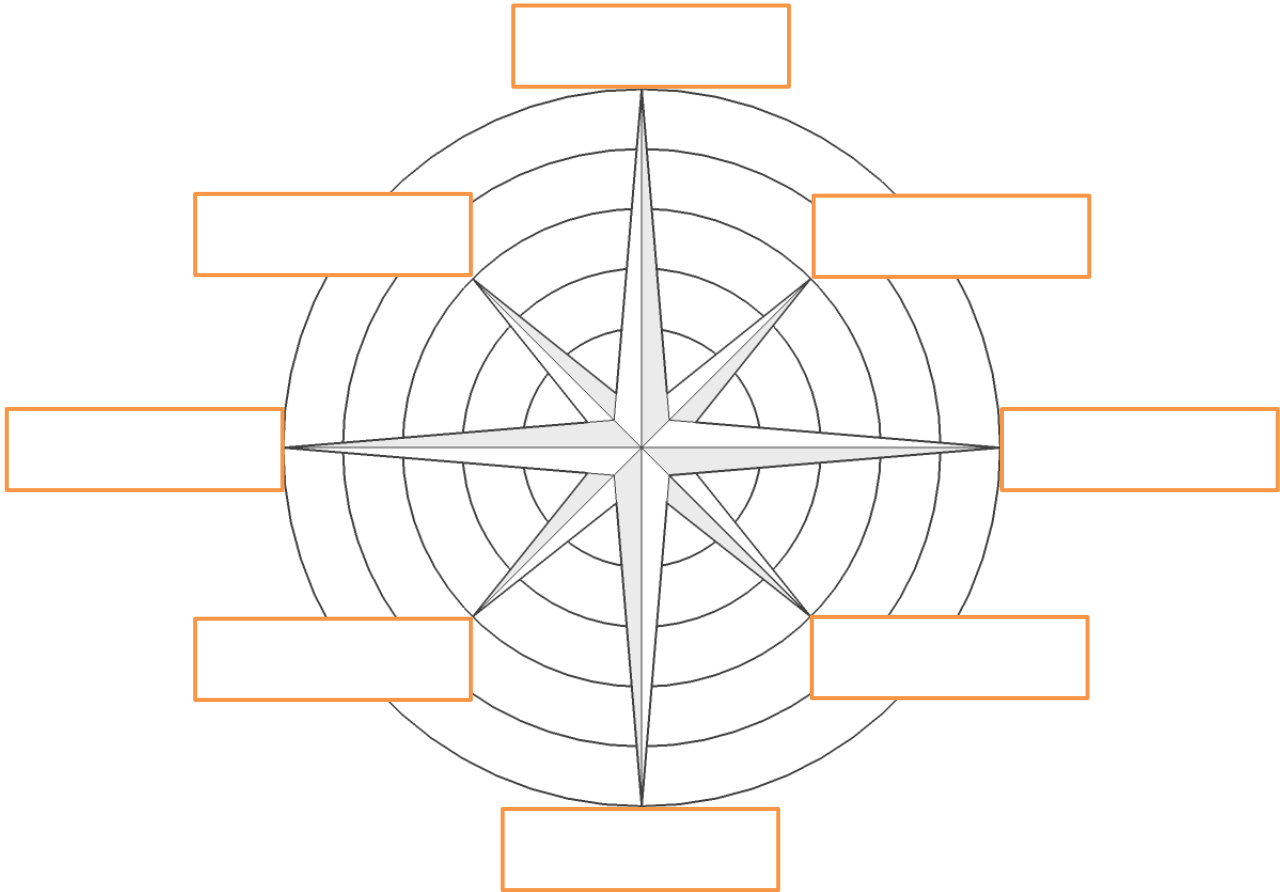


**Student activity**

Complete the following compass so that it shows the eight point compass directions.



Now write rhyme or mnemonic below to help you remember the four main compass directions:

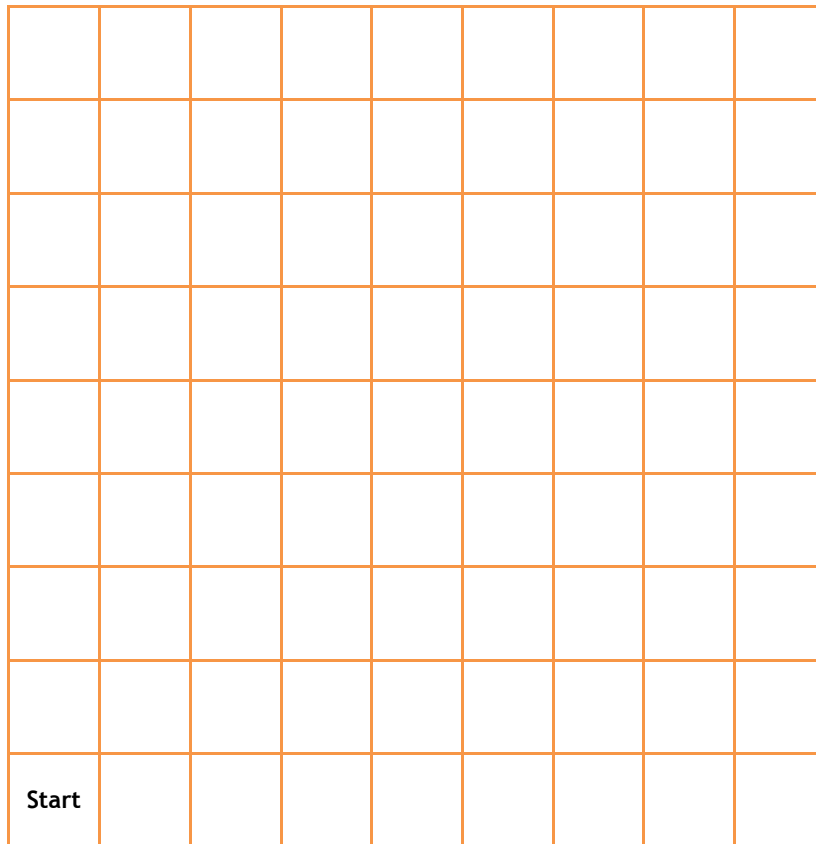

Using the compass you have completed follow the directions to help you find the treasure.



1. Begin at the **START** square, move two squares to the north, write the number **1** here.
2. Move three squares to the north east, write a number **2** here.
3. Move four squares to the south east, write a number **3** here.
4. Move two squares to the west, write a number **4** here.
5. Move five squares to the north west, write a number **5** here.
6. Move eight squares to the east, write a number **6** here.
7. Move two squares to the north west, write a number **7** here.
8. Move two squares to the south west, write a number **8** here.
9. Move two squares to the east, then five squares to the south west, write a number **9** here.
10. Move one square to the north, then three squares to the north east, write a number **10** here.
11. Move one square to the south, then two squares to the south east, put an **X** marks the spot!
