

# Geography SOW planner: 'how to...' guide

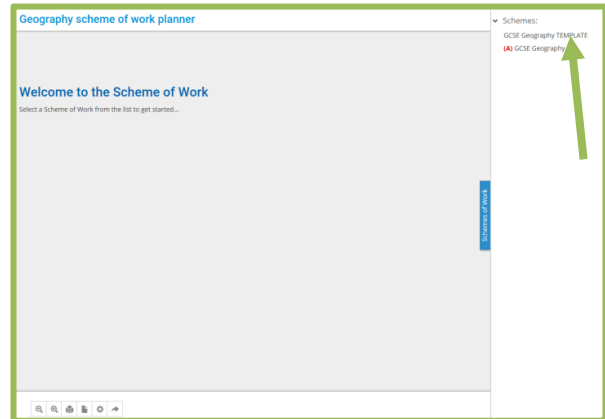
Follow this simple 'how to ...' guide to help you customise the AQA Geography GCSE scheme of work and access our pick of resources to support your teaching.

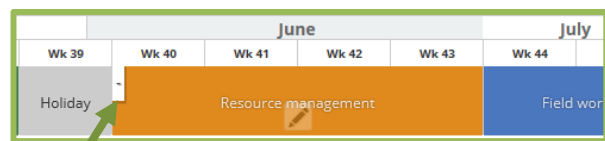
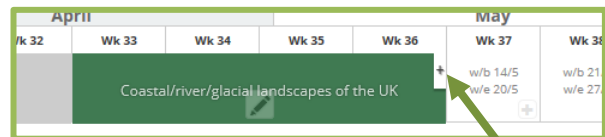
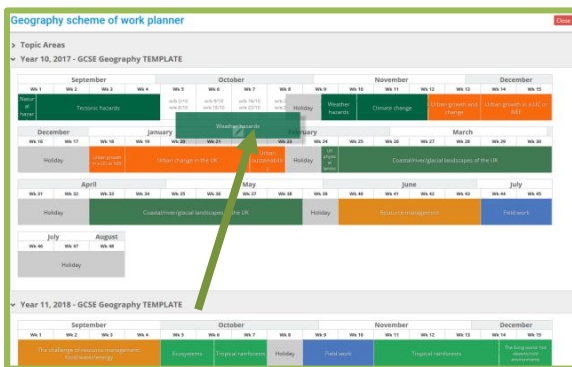
Free members can click on the links to access all the PDF resources. Subscribers can access all PowerPoints and Word documents, in addition to saving and printing customised plans.

Welcome to our AQA Geography GCSE scheme of work planner. To access the planner, click on the green link: 'Create your AQA Geography GCSE scheme of work'.

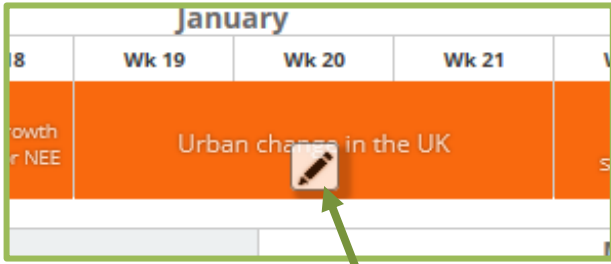
Click on 'GCSE Geography TEMPLATE' scheme to open up the interactive SOW, ready to customise.



Click and drag the individual tiles to place them in the order you wish to teach the topics. There are spare tiles for the longer units so you can place them either side of holidays should the topics need to be split. These are stored at the bottom of the SOW in the removed tiles section.

You can extend or reduce the size of the topic tiles by hovering over and clicking on the + or - signs which appear on each topic tile.

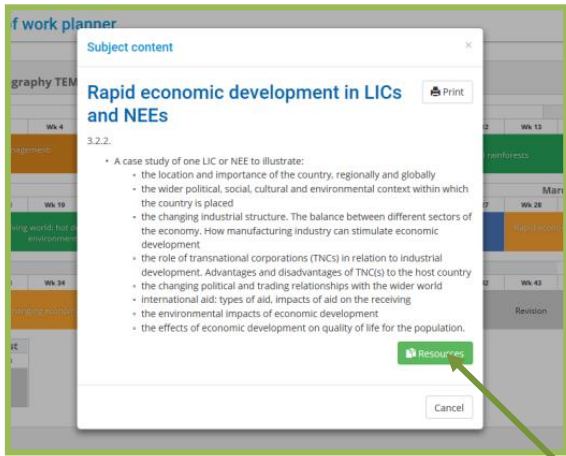
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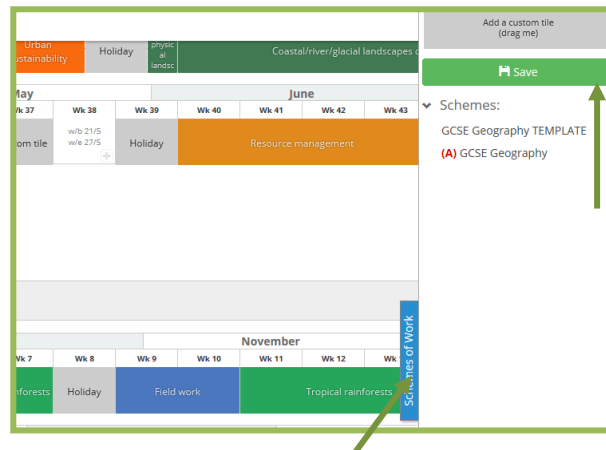
Edit the different topic tiles by hovering over and clicking on the edit button. Here you can add notes, change the colour of the tile or park it, which places it in the removed tiles section at the bottom of the SOW.



Add your own custom tiles by expanding the SOW side bar (click on the blue 'Schemes of Work' tab) and clicking and dragging the custom tile into place. You can then edit this tile by hovering over and clicking the edit button as before.



To access the subject content and resources for each topic area, click on the appropriate tile. This will show you the specification covered in the topic area. The green 'Resources' button at the bottom will take you to our pick of the best Teachit resources to support your teaching of this topic.



Don't forget to save the changes you have made to your SOW, using the save button in the expandable SOW side bar (click on the blue 'Schemes of Work' tab). You can rename here too.
