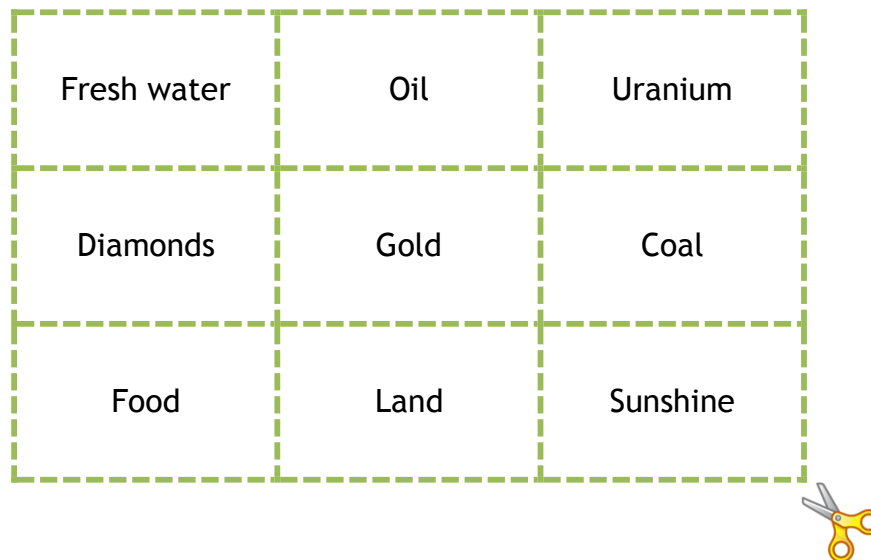

Be ready to justify your reasons!

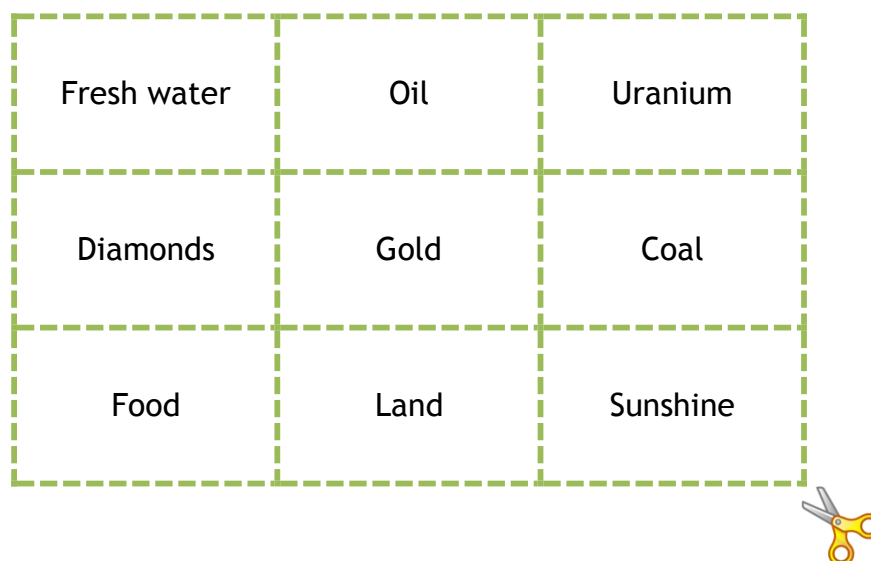
